OFFICIAL NOTICE: 2023 Transporter Permits Required for Each Debris Box or Vehicle Used to Transport Mixed Construction and Demolition Debris (Mixed C&D Debris) in the City and County of San Francisco

As part of its commitment to reduce solid waste generation by 15% and solid waste disposal by 50% by 2030, the City of San Francisco requires any person or company that collects or transports mixed C&D debris to obtain a permit from the San Francisco Environment Department (SFE). This requirement also intends to minimize illegal dumping and level the playing field for all compliant operators.

Any company that transports mixed C&D debris from San Francisco jobsites is required to obtain a permit for each debris box and/or each vehicle (all vehicles except for roll-off trucks) used to transport mixed C&D debris. Each vehicle or each debris box will need a 2023 permit to operate on or after January 1, 2023.

Please share this notification and the enclosed Construction and Demolition Debris Ordinance Update Fact Sheet with your members to help them understand the mixed C&D transporter permit requirements and the permit fee schedule.
