#### Recent Accomplishments:

- Chaired the SCTA CAC which oversees some \$30 million a year in Measure M funding for projects in Sonoma County. We have reviewed and approved funding for most of the Highway 101 projects, roundabouts in the Sonoma Valley, riverfront road and sidewalk improvements in Petaluma, and many other local projects and agencies that receive Measure M funding.
- 2. Chaired the committee that successfully passed the Go Sonoma Act which will follow the Measure M tax measure, expiring in 2024. The Go Sonoma Act will provide over \$20 million per year in funding for road infrastructure projects in Sonoma County for the next 20 years beginning in 2025. This is a direct benefit to our ECA businesses bidding on that work.
- 3. Provided expert legal opinions on new prevailing wage laws (particularly AB1851 in effect January 1, 2023) affecting the trucking firms that belong to the ECA and the contractors that utilize these trucking firms. This clarification helps to reduce contractor and trucking firm liability and enables them to pay the correct rates for hauling in materials that they otherwise might not know to do.
- 4. Advocated for an "escalator" clause in Sonoma County paving contracts to take the volatility out of oil price fluctuations for suppliers, contractors and the TPW themselves.
- 5. The ECA lobbied for raising the amount of single contract emergency work raised to \$150,000 for Sonoma County
- 6. The ECA provided an Emergency Services Manual update to all emergency service coordinators in Northern California to better enable fast contract awards if and when emergency work is needed. This manual puts ECA firms directly at the fingertips of staff handling emergency contracts in Sonoma County. Not only do the agencies appreciate that, but the ECA firms that get called do as well!
- 7. The ECA worked with landowners, and our other associations to point out that FEMA used incorrect information on recent flood zone mapping thereby negatively impacting many landowners needlessly as to how they can use their property, and what insurance costs they will experience. Current work is being done to correct those maps at considerable positive impact to both Sonoma County and those affected landowners.
- 8. Hosted several meetings with City of Santa Rosa staff to review and educate our members on recent changes to the Low Impact Development manual which has new compliance and enforcement actions that affect both public and private work that installs bioswale media and structural soil underneath planted areas. Contractors who are not aware of where to buy the materials (Stony Point Rock Quarry-Brett Wilmes), and how to properly install and caretake the import areas, are finding themselves tearing out their installed work at considerable expense.


