City of Santa Rosa Pushed Two Big Projects Out Before July 1, 2023, PLA Deadline

On July 1, 2023, the City of Santa Rosa will attach a Project Labor Agreement to all public works projects over \$500,000. There are no "carve outs" for local suppliers or truckers.

On Thursday, June 29, 2023, the City of Santa Rosa came out with their long-awaited project to fix the streets in Coffee Park and Fountaingrove due to fire related damages. This project is estimated to be around \$15,000,000 and has 66,000 tons of hot mix asphalt to out down. No PLA is attached to this project because it went out prior to July 1, 2023.

On Friday, June 30, 2023, the City of Santa Rosa came out with a 2nd huge project to fix Sonoma Avenue from E Street east. Again, since this project came out before July 1, there is no PLA attached to it.

I have been in many discussions with the City of SR regarding the effect the PLA could have on their projects for the past few months. I believe advocating for local quarries, batch plants and trucking firms played a major role in these two big projects coming out to bid before July 1. As you all know, I have been active in answering the city's staff questions regarding PLAs and how the city should try to find a way to allow local suppliers to bid on their public works projects. In a way, they did just that. However, for the next five years following these two big projects, local suppliers will need to sign on to the PLA and its requirements to be able to bid on future projects. Fair or unfair, that is what the rules are now. If you would like the County of Sonoma to know how your business feels about the City of SR PLA, you should contact the Supervisors and their contact information is on our website Click **HERE!** The County of Sonoma will be considering new PLA language on July 18, 2023. The ECA will not be speaking for or against the PLA so it is up to individual firms to take the time to call, email, or meet with your County leaders if you want to influence the outcome.





- 1. On Monday, June 26, 2023, I led the Sonoma County Transportation Authority's Citizens Advisory Committee in discussing SMART projects upcoming. SMART is moving forward with both the Windsor extension and will move forward with design and project solicitation for specific portions of the Healdsburg extension soon. By "specific portions" Eddie Cummins explained the crossing of the Russian River is the first "specific portion" SMART will be working on. SMART will be going over the river, not under it so a bridge is the specific portion of work SMART is going to be designing soon.
