
### **COMMITTEE NEWS**

Other issues to be discussed will be the recent submission for \$1,500 PAC donation by John to the PG & E group. PG&E used to be a regular member of the ECA and an annual donor to our PAC fund. When the fires hit, and our buddy Brian Bottari left their employ, they exited. John is trying to get them back in and this will be discussed by our ECA GAC on 9-19-23.

**ECA Specification Committee**-the ECA Spec Committee, led by Dale Smith and Casey Wood, will be meeting on 9-20-23 at 4:00pm to 5:30 pm at the NCBE main Board room.
