## Just the Facts, Please

I have heard that there has been a claim by the DIR for a local contractor to pay prevailing wages on a private project that has some work on a public right of way. Although I do not have any of the facts, this is an important issue that I have decided to address with a workshop this winter.

I do not understand how the DIR can make a determination that prevailing wages are required when there is no public funding involved. Work on a public right of way to do privately funded improvements does not constitute a requirement for paying prevailing wages in my experience. I am not attorney so I have reached out to an expert in this field and will have more news soon.

I want to be able to share "just the facts" with you all so you can apply the correct wages to your bids on private work in the near future.

This course covers proper procedures for making entry into Permit Required Confined Spaces. Participants are prepared to operate in the capacity of Entrant, Attendant or Entry Supervisor during confined space operations. Participants are familiarized with CFR 1910.146 and how to properly employ the permit program. This course is a combination of classroom instruction and practical application in actual permit spaces utilizing the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment, meters and ventilation. This course is required by OSHA before an employee can enter a Permit Required Confined Space. Certification of completion is provided.

#### EMERGENCY RESPONSE MANUAL ~ 2025—2026


















#### NORTH BAY CONSTRUCTION CORPS

The North Bay Construction Corps (NBCC) is an after-school, 3-month basic construction training program for seniors in their last semester of high school. Classes are taught by local contractors and construction managers. Participants are introduced to a variety of trades and earn certifications in Personal Protective Equipment and CPR/First Aid.

Each meeting is led by a contractor or tradesperson who presents information about his/her particular trade and then leads students through a hands-on skill-building activity. There is a strong focus on safety awareness at each meeting.
